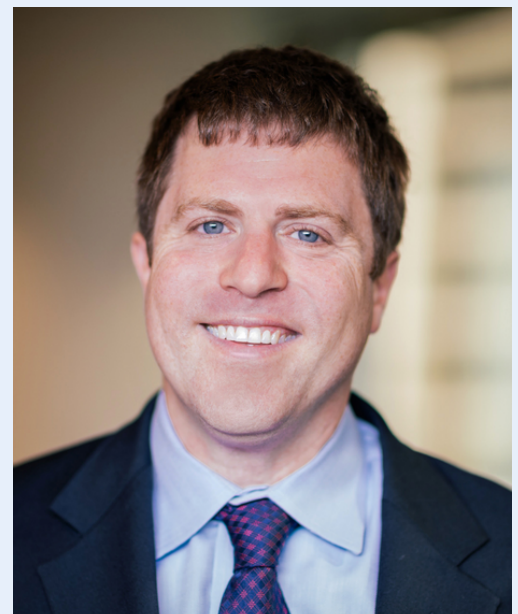
School Administrators' Conference
